


Create and Organize Order Preference List

Add Order to Preference List

Save time by creating a preference list for frequently placed orders.

If you find yourself changing the defaults of an order, save your order with changes to your preference list.

Once you have added the order, before signing click on the star to add to your preference list.
{Note you are not able to save as a favorite after signing the order}


1. Name within 'Display name' field.

Save variations of the same order for different purposes, such as categorizing by diagnosis.


Adding an order from your preference list

To add an order from your preference list, click on New Order.




Choose which section you would like to order from.

You can drill down into each subsection.

Check the orders you want to add, which will appear in the right-hand window.





First create sections that are useful to you, such as disease or body system sections. Then when you place commonly used order, you can save it as a favorite and add it to the correct section in your preference list.

Add subsections that group orders appropriately for your specialty. For example, you might add subsections for meds, labs and imaging to various disease sections.


Reorganize the sections and subsections by dragging and dropping them.



Once subsections have been created, drag and drop orders into the section. You can drag multiple orders by holding down the control button and highlighting several orders, that can then be dragged into a subsection.

Things to Remember

Within Preference list, right click to edit a previously saved order.



To save time creating a preference list, you can copy a list that other clinicians have created for certain types of orders. Click the 'Copy User' at the bottom of the Preference List Selector.
