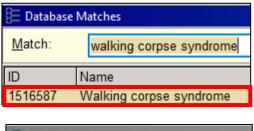
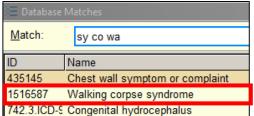

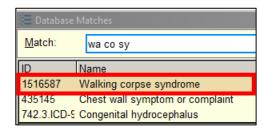
Searching within Data Base

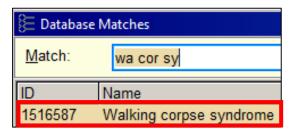
Tips for searching for a visit diagnoses, medication, order and/or problem.

- ✓ Enter any form or part of the phrase for which you are searching
- ✓ Search any word or combination of words in any order
- ✓ Include only as many characters as you are certain of, for any word or combination of words in the search.
- ✓ Exclude words by adding a minus sign "-" before a word, for example, acetaminophen -soln
- ✓ Use "or" logic by joining two search strings with a question mark "?", for example, FOOT?ANKLE











Filtered Search

Naming conventions can be used to filter searches.


- ✓ Generic Name
- ✓ Key Word (i.e. opth, otic, po, vaccine)
- ✓ Common Forms (i.e. tab, cap, oint, crea, soln, susp)






Searching Medication Frequency


Type the least number of characters.




✓ Try either using number symbols (1, 2, 3) or numerical words (one, two, three).



Common abbreviations may or may not have been used in the name: PRN versus as needed.





Day of the week frequencies use abbreviations for the day and assume Sunday is the first day of the week. Search "Every MO WE TH" or "Every SU TU TH", for example.
