

Flu vaccinations

To better ensure the health and well-being of the Beaumont team, patients and visitors, the Influenza Vaccination Program is extended to include all Beaumont Health team members, including those who work offsite.

Beaumont's policy supports required immunization for all health care providers – including private physicians with active hospital clinical privileges – unless a medical or religious contraindication exists.

Egg-free/albumin free vaccine products will also be offered for those who have high-level allergies or religious issues.

Flu vaccination clinics are scheduled at various locations and nursing units beginning Monday, Oct. 1. Calendars with flu clinic locations, dates, times and frequently asked questions can be found on this page. Check calendars often as they are subject to change.

All team members must complete the online consent form before receiving their vaccine.

Beaumont team members may obtain their influenza vaccination anywhere, but they are responsible for providing their legacy organization's employee/occupational health services departments with all required consents and documentation.

Team members who do not receive the vaccine because of an approved medical or religious exemption will be required to wear a mask when performing patient care activities during the influenza season, usually mid-November through April, as defined by the corporate epidemiologist.
