DISCHARGE MEDICATION PROGRAM



The Discharge Medication Program allows a patient's discharge medications to be filled and dispensed by the hospital outpatient pharmacy. The discharge medications are delivered to the patient at the bedside or family members may choose to pick up, if desired.

How to send prescriptions for patients

- Eprescribe to Beaumont Outpatient Pharmacy -Troy in Epic/oneChart or fax prescriptions, Discharge Medication Program Form and copy of prescription insurance card if available to 844-819-7257.
- If faxing, please place the original hard copy prescriptions in your units designated location (usually the patient's chart). The pharmacy technician will retrieve the hardcopies when delivering the prescriptions.
- Any prescriptions originally filled at our lobby pharmacy, with remaining refills, will be transferred to the patients home pharmacy upon request at the time of their first refill.
- Note: Allow one hour for processing and delivery of medication, so please send prescriptions at least one hour before close.
- If after program hours you MUST print the prescriptions and give to the patient or Eprescribe to the patient's pharmacy of choice.

- If the patient has opted out of the program, you will be prompted upon ordering meds at discharge to change the patient's home pharmacy.
- Prior authorizations will be handled by care coordinators.

What is the value to the patient and their partners in care?

- With convenient, bedside delivery of important medications needed to manage care after discharge, patients and their partners in care can focus on getting home more quickly to start the recovery process.
- We accept most insurances.
- Cash, credit card or check are accepted for payment of copay.
