

Critical Windows update underway & Data Classification and Protection Policy reminder

A critical Windows 10 update is being deployed to approximately 2,000 workstations across Beaumont through Friday, Sept. 24 at 2 a.m. **This update can take up to four hours or longer to complete. During this time, you will be unable to use your computer.**

If your computer receives this update, a message will appear. **Read carefully and don't just click OK.** You will be able to decide when this additional update begins to not disturb your workday, either right away, after your business hours or to be reminded later. [Review the tip sheet for full details and the screens you may see](#). Keep in mind, the update must be done in seven days of the first message appearing on the computer. After seven days, it will install automatically.

As a best practice reminder, **do not save files directly to your computer per the [Data Classification and Protection Policy](#)**. Move all files to a network drive, SharePoint or other file share location used by your team.
