MDHHS-5836, MICHIGAN PHYSICIAN ORDERS FOR SCOPE OF TREATMENT (MI-POST)

Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) (Revised 8-22)

The MI-POST legislation PA 154 was signed in 2017. The Rules were finalized in June 2022 and the MI-POST document, and the Patient and Family Information Sheet were finalized in August 2022.

What is the MI-POST? The MI-POST is intended for adult patients who have advanced illness resulting in a shortened life expectancy of a year or less. It is an optional two page, two sided out of hospital medical order that is a part of the advance care planning process that directs what care the patient should receive if they require medical attention. The MI-POST is executed by the patient's attending physician, nurse practitioner or physician assistant in collaboration with the patient (or the Patient Advocate (DPOA-H) or Legal Guardian when applicable).

The MI-POST is not intended to replace conversation when the time is available to engage in shared decision making.

Unlike other advance care planning directives, the MI-POST is <u>effective immediately</u> and aims to put the person's decisions into a medical order set. Other advance care planning directives do not constitute medical orders.

In acute care settings such as an EC or inpatient setting, the MI-POST is only advisory, meaning that it does not act as an order. However, in community settings it is an <u>actionable</u> document, ie EMS or a nursing facility will follow the orders that are written.
