## Myocardial Infarction Type 2

In order to capture the appropriate severity of illness, risk of mortality, complexity of care, and resource consumption...

### Myocardial Infarction Type 2:

- Diagnosis can be captured with the following documentation:
  - Type 2 MI
  - Myocardial infarction (MI) due to demand ischemia
  - Myocardial Infarction (MI) secondary to ischemic imbalance
- Documentation should link the etiology of the Type 2 MI to the diagnosis, for example:
  - Type 2 MI due to severe anemia
  - Type 2 MI due to acute respiratory failure/hypoxia
  - Type 2 MI due to hypotension or shock
  - Type 2 MI due to arrhythmia (specify type of arrhythmia)
- Do not document the following when a Type 2 MI is present:
  - Type 2 event
  - Type 2 demand ischemia
  - Elevated troponins due to type 2
