New compliance training modules have been developed for the 2019 Annual Education. These ongoing trainings and education on Beaumont's policies and procedures, legal obligations and compliance requirements are designed to mitigate risk and enable success.

2019 Annual Educational Requirements

- Physicians associated with Beaumont are required to participate in system-wide education on compliance, regulatory/accreditation and organizational activities.
- All Annual Education must be completed by **Wednesday, June 12, 2019**, with no exceptions.
- Email notifications from HealthStream (HS-Alerts@healthstream.com) will be sent on **Monday, April 15**, informing you of new education assignments.
- The number of courses to be completed is dependent on your role, area and relationship with Beaumont.
- Credentialed providers with Beaumont privileges are required to complete training as part of the requirements of the Corporate Integrity Agreement. Beaumont must meet the requirements of the CIA and other regulatory agreements or risk losing Medicare reimbursements.
