# Why pack-years matter

Higher exposure means higher risk for lung cancer



Pack-years is a way to measure a smoker's exposure to tobacco.

**1** **x** **20** **=** **20**  
Pack years pack  
a day years years

**2** **x** **10** **=** **20**  
Packs pack  
a day years years

Having a smoking history of 20 pack-years or more may make you eligible for an annual lung cancer screening.
